Important Information Regarding the Inactive Voter Registration List

Most counties are conducting their November 5, 2013 muncipal election(s) by mail ballot. Only voters on the Active voter registration list are mailed ballots. If you are on the Inactive voter registration list, you must contact your county election office to update your registration information or to confirm your existing information before a ballot will be mailed to you.

Why was I placed on the Inactive List?

1. If you are on the Inactive Voter Registration List it is because

- a. you did not vote in a federal general election and you did not respond to two confirmation mailings sent to you by the county election office, *or*
- b. you had a mail ballot returned to the county election office as undeliverable and you did not respond to a confirmation mailing sent to you by the county election office.

Reactivating your Registration is Easy!

2. You may reactivate your voter registration by

- a. Notifying your <u>county election office</u> in writing that your voter registration information is current *or*
- b. appearing at your precinct's polling place and confirming your current voter registration information or updating your voter registration information by filling out a <u>voter registration form</u> (note: if you appear at the polling place and update your registration information to another precinct, you may still vote one last time at your old precinct/polling place) *or*
- c. requesting an absentee ballot for any election or
- d. providing a new or updated <u>voter registration form</u> to the county election office.
