

CALL FOR BIDS: ASPHALT REPAIR / CHIP or SCRUB SEAL PROJECTS

Roberts/Cooney Dam Road and West Pryor Road

Notice is hereby given that the Carbon County Road Department is seeking bids for placement of asphalt and the chip or scrub seal of:

- 1) Approximately 2 miles (10,560ft.) of 24ft. wide road, or 28,160 square yards (SY) of Scrub Seal on the Roberts to Cooney Dam Road from the intersection of US 212 at Roberts, to where the pavement ends approximately 100 yds. beyond the intersection of the Cottonwood Rd.
 - i) Laydown 1.5" asphalt at various locations with a total length of 800', or 2134 SY, approximately 180 ton prior to Scrub Seal

- 2) Approximately 1.9 miles(10,032') of 24ft. wide road, or 26,752 square yards (SY) of Chip Seal on the West Pryor Road from intersection of US 310 to Mont Aqua Rd.
 - i) Laydown 1.5" asphalt at various locations with a total length of 2300', or 6133 SY, approximately 507 tons prior to chip seal.

SCOPE OF WORK:

Successful contractor must;

1. Remove debris from cracks, Clean and prep the road surface.
2. Laydown 1.5" asphalt material delivered by Carbon County
3. Chip seal using approximately .32 to .45 gallons of CRS-2P or equivalent emulsified asphalt and 25 lbs. / SY of 3/8 chips.
4. Shot rate and lbs. / SY may vary depending on roadway condition.
5. Follow Montana Department of Transportation Asphalt Manual guidelines
6. Provide appropriate traffic control.
7. Removal of excess chips
8. Repaint centerline, double yellow solid stripes.

Carbon County will:

1. Stockpile 3/8" chips for contractor at agreed locations
2. Deliver B-Modified asphalt, PG 64-22 oil, from Fisher Sand and Gravel to sites for contractor to load into paver.

Bids must contain proof of Worker's Compensation Insurance, and Liability Insurance in the amount of at least \$2,000,000. Bidders must comply with Davis Bacon Wage Rates and use taxed fuel. Successful bidder must give Carbon County at least 24 hours of notice before work begins. Carbon County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or portions thereof. Bids will be reviewed for product quality and warranty as well as lowest bid.

Successful bidder shall perform the work as soon as weather allows and before June 20th, 2017 and give Carbon County at least 24 hours of notice before work begins. Bids may be mailed or delivered to Carbon County Clerk and Recorder, PO Box 887, Red Lodge Montana, 59068 or left with the Clerk and Recorders office at 17 West 11th Street in Red Lodge. Bids will be accepted until 11:00 AM, September 12, 2016 and will be opened at that time.
