II Weed Management Plan

Improvement Agreement

A. Need

According to the Carbon county Weed Management Plan "...noxious weeds have been and are a serious problem in Carbon County. The noxious weeds found in Carbon County were introduced through feed, seed, hay, and vehicles. They have established and continue to spread with the aid of wildlife, domestic animals, wind, water, and people. Subdividing of property and recreation has accelerated the problem."

The noxious weed management plan identifies the need for noxious weed control within subdivisions. Often when farm or ranchland is taken out of production or is subdivided, weeds begin to grow and spread. Some absentee landowners fail to control weeds and weed control problems are also associated with vacant or undeveloped subdivisions.

Noxious weeds are controlled by a combination of methods including spraying, grazing, cutting and biological methods. The weed management plan will assist landowners in identifying measures to control noxious weeds within a subdivision.

B. Noxious Weed List

A "Noxious Weed" is a plant considered to be extremely harmful or destructive to the environment, replaces native plant life and is declared "noxious" by law.

Noxious weeds in Carbon County are those declared so by the Weed Board and are prioritized accordingly. These weeds will be managed to achieve two affects.

(1) Limit and prevent the spread of noxious weeds from existing infestations to uninfected sites.

(2) To eventually reduce the overall size of the existing infestations.

The following weeds exist in the county and/or have been declared "noxious" for Carbon County by the Weed Board.
