

CARBON COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 98-1

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON ALL COUNTY ROADS IN CARBON COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CARBON COUNTY:

1. The maximum speed limit on all county roads within Carbon County is between 35 miles per hour and 55 miles per hour. Said limits to become effective upon the placement, by the Board, of signs posting said limits.
2. A person convicted of violating this ordinance shall be fined not less than five (\$5.00) dollars or more than one hundred dollars (\$100).
3. All fines and forfeitures collected by any court for a violation of this ordinance must be paid to the Carbon County Treasurer and by him credited to the general fund of the County.
4. Nothing in this ordinance shall impose or alter any speed limit on Highway 308 (the Red Lodge to Belfry Road) or Highway 421 (the Joliet to Columbus Road).
5. This ordinance is effective 30 days after passage and approval.
