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## RESOLUTION 2022-10

### RESOLUTION TO INITIATE STUDY FOR INTERIM ZONING REGULATIONS ON THE SALE AND PRODUCTION OF MARIJUANA and MARIJUANA BUSINESSES

**WHEREAS**, 76-2-206 of the Montana Code Annotated give a board of county commissioners the authority to enact interim zoning regulations for an emergency that involves public health, safety, morals, or general welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the interim regulations are meant to allow the board to have time to study the situation or formulate a permanent plan to deal with the situation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Carbon County Board of Commissioners passed a Resolution of Intent to Enact Interim Zoning Regulations on the Sale and Production of Marijuana on February 10, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the Carbon County Board of Commissioners held a duly noticed Public Hearing on March 3, 2022 regarding interim zoning regulations on the sale and production of marijuana and marijuana businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 3, 2022 the Carbon County Board of Commissioners passed Resolution 2022-07 to Enact Interim Zoning Regulations on the Sale and Production of Marijuana and Marijuana Businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, 76-2-206(1)(b) Montana Code Annotated requires within 30 working days that the county initiate a study or investigation to verify that an emergency exists and to identify the facts and circumstances that constitute the emergency.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Carbon County Board of Commissioners hereby call for a study or investigation into impacts from the sale and production of marijuana and marijuana businesses; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Carbon County Board of Commissioners task the Carbon County Planning Board with the investigation.
