### **ELEMENTARY BUILDING RESERVE FUND LEVY PROPOSITION**

Shall the district be authorized to levy an additional \$60,000 per year for five (5) years and being approximately 5.17 mills for the purpose of repairing and maintaining district facilities including: secure building access for student safety; electrical repairs and upgrades; plumbing repairs and upgrades; boiler repair; gymnasium floor refinishing; maintain water heaters; asphalt repair; concrete repair; roof replacement/repair; kitchen appliance upgrades; and lease and equip modular classrooms. Passage of this proposal will increase annual taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$6.98 and on a home with a market value of \$300,000 by approximately \$20.93, and on a home with a market value of \$600,000 by approximately \$41.86. An increase in property taxes may lead to an increase in rental costs.

If this proposition is approved, it will hereby be limited to 5 years.

### **HIGH SCHOOL BUILDING RESERVE FUND LEVY PROPOSITION**

Shall the district be authorized to levy an additional \$60,000 per year for five (5) years and being approximately 4.71 mills for the purpose of repairing and maintaining district facilities including: secure building access for student safety; electrical repairs and upgrades; plumbing repairs and upgrades; boiler repair; gymnasium floor refinishing; maintain water heaters; asphalt repair; concrete repair; roof replacement/repair; kitchen appliance upgrades; and lease and equip modular classrooms. Passage of this proposal will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$6.36 and on a home with a market value of \$300,000 by approximately \$19.08, and on a home with a market value of \$600,000 by approximately \$38.15. An increase in property taxes may lead to an increase in rental costs.

If this proposition is approved, it will hereby be limited to 5 years.
